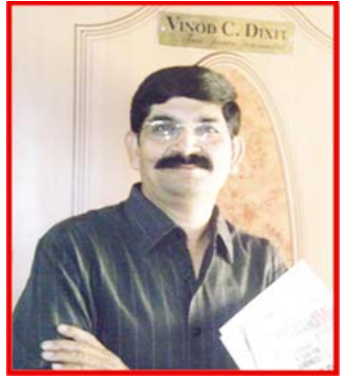


# Need to play role to ensure healthier environment for a healthy living
